

The earliest recorded deed in the Dutchess County, NY. (Hudson Valley area) occurred when three Indian who lived near a well know creek, deeded, or as the Indian did not understand private property, they "donated" the land to Arnout Velie in June of 1680. Later this transaction is described as the Arnant Comelise Velie deed. Spelling, even of names was up to the writer. The name Velie appears to be spelled interchangeable at this period, with Viele or Velius (Latin for Sailmaker). The name is Dutch. There were lots of Velies around Pleasant Valley and La Grange, NY. The Henry & Susan farm of 200 acres was about 75 miles north of New York on the Hudson River near Hyde Park. Henry & Susan, sons George, & Charles, and daughter Susan are all buried on this farm plot.
